ORDINANCE NO. 16-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 82-3 RELATING TO
ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF FREDERICA IN COUNCIL MET:

Section 1. That Section 82-3 of the Frederica Code be amended by striking the fourth sentence thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
Should any police officer or animal control officer be unable, after using reasonable and diligent efforts, to apprehend a vicious animal, he or she may destroy it.

Repealer: All ordinances and part of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after adoption.


