TOWN ELECTIONS

The Annual Municipal Election shall be held at the Frederica Fire Department on Saturday, **March 3, 2018** from 12:00 to 5:00 PM. YOU MUST BE A REGISTERED VOTER IN THE TOWN OF FREDERICA TO VOTE IN THE ELECTIONS. Call or stop in to Town Hall to see if you've registered. This years elections will be for (1) Council member and for the seat of Mayor. Interested candidates may submit a letter of intent IN PERSON during regular business hours at Town Hall through **January 26, 2018**.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Credit Cards and Debit Cards can now be used for payments at Town Hall. There is a 2.65% Convenience Fee (Minimum fee of \$3.00) per transaction, which are handled directly by the Credit Card Processor.

WATER SHUT OFFS

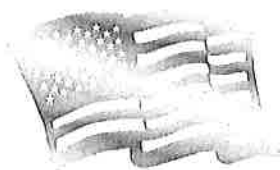
Reminder-Water shut-offs for delinquent accounts are the 3rd Saturday of every month. Payments need to be made prior to the 2nd Saturday of the month to avoid getting a door-hanger notice. Notices are generated on town provided utilities, (Both Trash AND Water account balances). There is a \$50.00 Fee in addition to the balance owed to reconnect water services after shut off due to delinquency. NO Exceptions.

Snow and Ice Removal

Just a reminder as winter months approach – Please be sure to care for the sidewalks around your property. From grass trimmings in the summer and fall to ice and snow in the winter, residents have 24 hours to clear sidewalks for pedestrian traffic. If the Town has to clear the sidewalks after that time period, fines will be assessed. Help keep our Town safe and clean!

REMINDER

Bills not paid on time will have interest added every month immediately after the due date. It is a 1.5% interest rate on property taxes, and 2% interest rate on trash and water.
