## REMINDER: Shut-off Notices

If you are two (2) quarters behind on your trash and water, you will receive a shut-off notice. This notice is to remind you that payment is due on your account immediately. If no payment is received, your water will be shut off the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month. Any account over 30 days past due will be charged 2% interest per month on outstanding balance.

## TRASH PICKUP

The Town is having some problems with the amount of trash being set out for pickup. Here are the guidelines for weekly pickup.

- 1- 1-96 gal. container and 1 bag of trash OR
- 2- 3 - 32 gal. Containers and 1 bag of trash.
- 3- 1- Bundle of limbs- 4x4- and it must be tied together.
- 4- For large bulk items - 1 per house- but please call Town Hall so that we can notify the trash company.
- 5- Also, it has been suggested that you put your house number on the lid(s) of your trash and recycle containers in case they get blown into the street so that they can be returned to the correct house.

**ELECTIONS.** Being registered with the State of Delaware does not entitle you to vote in the Town elections. If you are not sure if you are registered, contact Town Hall during normal business hours.

The election this year consists of one (1) Council member and the office of Mayor. You may be considered for candidacy for an office by filing, **IN PERSON**, at the Town Hall during regular business hours, not earlier than the opening of business on December 7, 2015 and prior to the close of business on the last Friday of January which is January 29, 2016.

All notifications of candidacy will be presented to the Town Council at the regularly scheduled meeting in February.
