Congratulations to the winners, and special thanks to everyone who participated. Remember – Cash prizes for the first three spots!

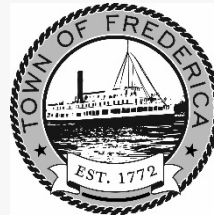
The Town also now has signs to place in the yards of the winning houses for future years!

## MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The next election will be held **March 2, 2019** at the Frederica Fire Department. The election will be for three (3) council seats. Please remember that to vote in Municipal elections, you must register at Town Hall at least 30 days prior to an election – by **January 31, 2019**. Registration via the DMV does NOT automatically register you with the Town. Any person who is a citizen of the United States, has lived within the Town limits for one (1) year prior to the Election, is at least 18 years of age, is registered to vote with the Town of Frederica, has not been convicted of a felony, and is not delinquent in monies owed to the Town is qualified to run for an open Council Seat. Stop by Town Hall if you have any questions about running for a Council seat!

## WATER SHUT-OFFS

Water shut-offs for delinquent accounts are on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month unless otherwise posted. Delinquent accounts include Trash AND Water. A \$50.00 fee in addition to the balance owed is required to reconnect water service after it has been shut off. NO EXCEPTIONS.

## TRASH CAN REMINDERS

Please remember to remove your trash and recycling cans away from the curb by the evening hours on pick up day. Cans should be placed out the evening before pickup as the company may come as early as 6:00 AM on pickup day. Each home should also only have one trash can, unless you have made other arrangements to pay for an additional service. Cans are tracked by their serial number. Removing and/or using a can from another property location is considered theft of services and is punishable by law.

## STREET LIGHTS

Have you notice a street light out? Or maybe one that cycles on and off?

If you notice a problem with a street light near your home or anywhere throughout town, let Town Hall know, and we can get repairs scheduled. Light poles have two sets of 5 digit numbers, but if you dont have that, a nearby address and description will work as well.

## WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS

As snow and ice arrive, resident's have 24 hours to clear sidewalks for pedestrian traffic.

If you have a fire hydrant on your property, please clean at least 3 feet around it as well.

Please park in your driveway when snow is expected so that roads may be cleared quickly and efficiently.

Failure to comply with the above may result in fines, and also risks the safety and security of our residents. Please help keep our town safe and clean!
