WATER SHUT-OFFS

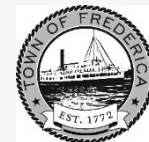
As of July 1, 2019 All utility bills must be **paid by the due date.** Water service may be terminated for any balances unpaid 10 days after the due date.

GRASS CUTTING

Please remember to stay on top of grass cutting during the summer months. Each property owner is responsible for maintaining their yards according to the Frederica Town Code. Grass and weeds should always be kept below 6", bushes should be trimmed, and tree limbs should be trimmed back so they are not hanging over neighbor's yards or streets and sidewalks. Grass clippings should be blown back into yards rather than onto sidewalks or streets. Dumpsters are always available for yard waste – just contact Town Hall for access! Please feel free to contact our Code Enforcement Office to discuss what is and is not permitted for property maintenance. If your property is not maintained, the Town will be forced to perform the work and assess fines to your account.

TRASH CAN REMINDERS

Please remember to remove your trash and recycling cans away from the curb by the evening hours on pick up day. Cans should be placed out the evening before pickup as the company may come as early as 6:00 AM on pickup day. Each home should also only have one trash can, unless you have made other arrangements to pay for an additional service. Cans are tracked by their serial number. Removing and/or using a can from another property location is considered theft of services and is punishable by law.

**STREET LIGHTS**

Have you notice a street light out? Or maybe one that cycles on and off?

If you notice a problem with a street light near your home or anywhere throughout town, let Town Hall know, and we can get repairs scheduled. Light poles have two sets of 5 digit numbers, but if you dont have that, a nearby address and description will work as well.
