SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL

Sidewalks need to be cleared for pedestrian traffic no more than 24 hrs. after the snow or ice has stopped falling. REMINDER in Waters Edge Development, there is NO on street parking 2 hours after snowfall.

YARD MAINTENANCE

With colder weather comes leaves, leaves and more leaves! Please remember that bushes should be trimmed, and tree limbs should be cut back from streets and neighbor's properties. CONTRACTORS LICENSE

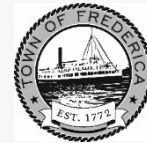
If you are having a contractor working on your home, they must have a Frederica Contractors License. The contractor must also have a Delaware State Business License and Proof of Insurance.

VOTER REGISTRATION

TO VOTE IN THE TOWN OF FREDERICA ELECTIONS, YOU MUST REGISTER WITH THE TOWN CLERK AND SIGN A VOTER REGISTRATION CARD. YOU MUST BE REGISTERED BY JANUARY 31, 2021 IN ORDER TO VOTE IN THE MARCH ELECTION.

UTILITY BILLS

The 4th Quarter utility bills are due on January 31, 2021. Please pay before or on the due date to prevent late fees. If you are unable to pay the utility bills due to the COVID19 pandemic, please contact our Town Hall and speak to the Town Clerk to make an arrangement.

TRASH CAN REMINDERS



Please remember to remove your trash and recycling cans away from the curb by the evening hours on pick up day. Cans should be placed out no earlier than 6:00 PM the evening before pickup as the company may come as early as 6:00 AM on pickup day. Each home should also only have one trash can, unless you have made other arrangements to pay for an additional service. Cans are tracked by their serial number. Removing and/or using a can from another property location is considered theft of services and is punishable by law.

SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT

If you are 65 years of age or older you could be eligible for 10% off of the water portion of your quarterly utility bill. You must reside in and own your home for a minimum of 5 years. To get your discount go to the Town Hall and sign up with Alice Green.



DID YOU KNOW?

The Town of Frederica is part of a grant of land originally deeded to Mr. Boneny Bishop by William Penn in 1681 and designated on survivors records as St. Collom. The bend on the Murderkill River that later became the port was first called Indian Point.

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms reported – from mild symptoms to severe illness.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19.

If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face
