READING AND APPROVAL OF THE LAST MEETING MINUTES:

Councilmember Maddox made a motion with a second by Councilmember Summers to approve the minutes of the Oct 20, 2021 meeting. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

WATER DEPT. / TREASURER’S / POLICE / CODE ENF. REPORT

Police Dept: Councilmember Maddox made a motion with a second by Councilmember Summers to approve the Police Dept. report. Councilmember Rager thanked Lt Darling for having both officers on duty for Halloween. All agreed that it was a nice safe event for the Children. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Water / Code Dept: Dustan reported that he is work with Commissioner Buckson on trying to get the State to approve property for our water tower and had met with Chesapeake Gas about natural gas. They had also just finished cleaning up a property on S Market with Sunnyfield Construction. Pre-construction meeting for the Front St. water main project is 10.4.2021. He had also been sent drawings for the sidewalk / bike path project along Frederica Rd. Councilmember Maddox made a motion with a second by Councilmember Rager to approve the Water / Code report. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

PLANNING COMMISSION REPORT: Mandy Slody presented the following permits:

Mayor Glanden replied that sidewalks along Frederica Rd from Waters Edge to Asbury Square were not planned because it would involve private property and that we hoped to have approval for Town Police protection on Frederica Rd.

Mandy Slody asked about sending a letter to the school concerning traffic waiting to pick up children at the school along Frederica Rd blocking the Post Office and Family Dollar.

Dustan Russum said he would revisit the school and it was decided to paint the no parking areas along Frederica Rd yellow to warn people not to park there. It was also reported that the Town Police could give citations for parking in the marked areas.

COUNCILMEMBER COMMENTS: Councilmember Rager reported that he would be supporting Mayor Glanden in his reelection for 2022 and thanked all for a great year working together on the council. Council agreed that it was a great year working together and that we had got a lot accomplished.
