TOWN OF FREDERICA ORDINANCE NO. 25-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 314, RENTAL PROPERTIES, SUBSECTION 17, INSPECTIONS, TO AMEND THE RENTAL PROPERTY INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS AND FEES

WHEREAS, the Town of Frederica has the authority to regulate rental properties to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council deem it necessary to amend the existing rental inspection provisions to ensure compliance, timely inspections, and cost recovery for enforcement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Frederica, Delaware:

Section 1. Amendment of Chapter 314-17, Inspections.

§314-17 shall hereby be amended by deleting the current text in its entirety. §314-17 shall read as follows:

314-17. Inspection required, fees, enforcement.

- A. <u>Enforcement Authority</u>. The Town of Frederica Code Enforcement Officer, or such other designee as the Town Council may authorize, shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.
- B. Fees. All residential rental properties within the Town of Frederica shall be subject to one (1) inspection annually, to be completed no later than March 1 of each calendar year. Inspections may be performed by the Town of Frederica or by a duly authorized third-party contractor approved by the Town.
 - (a) <u>Annual Inspection Fee</u>. The fee for each required annual rental property inspection shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per unit inspected.
 - (b) Re-Inspection Fee. If a re-inspection is required due to violations noted in the initial inspection, the property owner shall pay a One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) fee for each such re-inspection.

C. <u>Deadline</u>. All required inspections must be completed no later than March 1 of each calendar year.

D. <u>Penalty for Non-Compliance</u>. Any property owner who fails to complete the required inspection by March 1 shall be subject to a civil fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for each day the property remains out of compliance, beginning March 2 and continuing until the inspection is completed.

Section 2. Severability.

If any section, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be found invalid, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days from and after its approval by Council.

Section 4. Repealer:

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
