- Dustan Russum presented the Water, Code Enforcement, and Police Reports, notable points are as follows:

The last of the current funding was used up. an unknown water line was found, but it was not the missing interconnect. In the springtime we should be able to ask for more grant money from the office of drinking water.

Pertaining to code enforcement, the rental property license paperwork has been mailed out.

Pertaining to Police part-time officer Jared Bosenberg first reported for duty yesterday, and began to familiarize himself with the equipment and facilities. He is currently working under temporary permission from POST, preceding their next formal meeting in February. Regular duty activities are estimated to begin in about 2 weeks time.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

- Discussion was opened regarding the office of Chief of Police.
- Councilwoman Virginia Simpler excused herself at 8:28 PM.

- A motion was made seconded and unanimously approved by the three remaining Council Members to extend an offer to Brian K. Darling for the position of Chief of Police. In addition a base salary of \$90,000.00 with a contract period of 3 years and a 6 month probationary period was agreed upon. Further contract formalities are to follow.
