- A Public Hearing was opened for Ordinance 26-05 *An ordinance amending Chapter 425, Water*
- Christiana Johnston of 254 S. Market st. spoke against a rate increase.
- With no further comments, the public hearing was closed and the regular order of business began.
- A motion was made and carried unanimously to accept the minutes from the previous meeting in written form.

- Dustan Russum presented the Water, Code Enforcement, and Police Reports, notable points were as follows:
 - Work on the Central Market Street Water Main Project is anticipated to start in approximately 1 month.
 - Funding has finally become available to continue the Water Main Repair on Jackson Street. Teal Construction anticipates work to begin in 3 - 4 weeks.
 - Pertaining to Police, a contract with Axion is being negotiated for body cameras and dash cameras.
- A motion was made and carried unanimously to accept the Water, Code Enforcement, and Police Reports.
- The Planning Commission had no business.

OPEN FLOOR

- Christiana Johnson of 254 S. Market St. spoke a montage of things.

NEW BUSINESS

- Ordinance 26-05 *An ordinance amending Chapter 425, Water* was called to a vote and unanimously approved.
- Although on the agenda, no representatives for the Little Ducklings Daycare appeared or gave notice. Council voted to table any review or action.
- A bid of \$5300.00 was secured through Penoni Engineering to conduct a survey of the Town Hall, its grounds and improvements; and to create a Plat Plan of it. Council voted unanimously to approve this bid, and initiate the survey.

- Leonard MacDonell, presented a proposal to install outdoor vending machines in the Town park. A sample contract was furnished, and given to the Town Solicitor for review pending any action. The subject was therefore tabled.
- The proposal for Police body cameras through Axion, which was discussed earlier in Dustan Russum's reports, was brought up for formal action. After some discussion Council voted unanimously to engage the services of Axion, for the police cameras.

OLD BUSINESS

- The Town Hall "front door options" were tabled, pending the completion of the Parcel survey.
- There were no new Police general Orders - No Action.
- The Comprehensive Plan has been submitted to the Office of State Planning. It is scheduled for PLUS review on July 1st.
- At 7:59 pm, Council moved unanimously to adjourn the meeting.
